#### II. Brief Overview

- □ General
  - International Toilet Culture Conference was co-hosted by Ajou University(Graduate School of Public Affairs). From keynote speech to 9 special lectures, activities of WTA for past 10 years were evaluated, and directions, strengthen of roles and activity goals for next decades were dealt with through whole conference.
     Foreign participants were interested in new toilet technologies, as well as in UN SDGs Goal 6, IFRC's Water and Sanitation Activity, associative relation between tourism and sanitation, WTA's Globalization,
    - and some case study delivered by various speakers. Conference was fruitful with those lectures, and well-organized.
  - 10 out of 14(Presidential Group 5, BOD 9) of Board Members attended at the 9<sup>th</sup> BOD Meeting, and dealt 9 agendas for GA and BOD Meeting itself for 2 hours. Upon agendas for General Assembly, new board member(presidential group, board of directors and auditor) election(4th Term), venue and time of next BOD Meeting and GA(Candidate-South Africa presented their proposal), and other major agendas were dealt with. For the BOD decision case, financial problem was be discussed related to an international scale organization. Pre-meeting was organized prior to the BOD Meeting, but still actual meeting time was more than we expected.

At the 4<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, 72 participants from 14 countries including observer countries(Zambia, Turkey, Japan). Agendas of Election of GA Chairman, New Board Member Election, Revision of Constitution, Venue of Next GA and BOD Meeting was discussed and decided.

Also newly elected Board of Directors, Delegations from Observers, and Prof. Shin Kue Ryu on behalf of conference speakers delivered their greetings, and all participants made a resolution of WTA's developments for a new decade.

It was little but exhausted because Field Trip was 1 night 2days away from base camp-SUWON, but programs were good including highway resting area toilets and Pyeongchang Winter Olympic facilities, as well as atmosphere among the participants was good too.

Due to cold weather and snow, foreign participants visited indoor places more including Seo-ho Ecological Water Resource Center(Sewage Plant). SUWON Traditional Culture Museum, Haewoojae-Toilet Museum, well UNESCO World as as Heritage Hawseong Temporary Palace.

- $\Box$  Good Point
  - O There was no special strong point at the event, but under the circumstances of lace of budget, Secretariat cooperated with Gyeonggi MICE Bureau and Ajou University for fund-raising. This kind of cooperation will help expanding sponsorship form various field. Also, Suwon's support including manpower was very much helpful.

#### 🗌 Failings

- Field Trip was too short with too many programs, it was very hectic and exhausting.
- Conference participants from domestic(Korean) toilet companies were too small amount.
- Cooperation with hotel management for the preparation was not smooth enough.
- Participants would come to the scene without much information of meeting materials.

#### 2 Matters for Decision

#### 1. World Toilet Associaiton Constitution Revision(Passed)

Article 7.(Organs) The work of the WTA shall be carried out by the General Assembly, the Board of Directors, and the Secretariat. The WTA may establish advisory boards, special committee, <u>branch</u> and subsidiary organs and ad hoc committees as deemed necessary. <u>Provided that matter related</u> to operation are decided by the president separately.

• Article 8. (Membership Categories and Voting rights)

1. The <u>four</u> membership categories are defined as follows:

a. Association members shall be open to national toilet associations representing their respective countries.

b. **Government members** shall be open to national and other levels of local government.

c. <u>Organization members</u> shall be open to inter-governmental international organizations, civic organizations, academic institutions, and toilet-related industries.

d. Individual members are based on the members that were recommended by category 1, 2 or 3.

 Article 37. (Revenue) The WTA shall finance its expenses with the revenue raised from any of the following sources:

a. Membership dues and assessed contributions;

b. Subsidies from national or local governments and revenue from their commissioned activities;

c. Proceeds from international organizations, foundations, corporations and <u>individuals</u> entrusted to the WTA, as well as revenue from their commissioned activities; and

d. Proceeds from other business operations.

# 2. Establishment of Branch in Each Country's Toilet Association(Passed)

- Any country who are available to establish the branch, can do it according to local circumstances, and operated flexibly.
- The head of each branch : should be Chairman, not a president.
- Actions related to Article 41 was dealt with together. (Actions Related to Establishment and Operation of WTA

Branch Office)

#### 3. Advisory Committee Establishment(Passed)

- Experts from various field should be invited
- From our members, we need to invite someone representing the continent or country, or industry
- For the various view, committee should be organized with different type of experts such as not only technical engineer also social scientist, NGO, etc.(The experts on rights for women and disadvantaged people should be included equally as UN SDGs has focused on them.)
- Actions related to Article 41 was dealt with together.(WTA Advisory Committee Regulation)




#### 4 Adoption of ANGKOR Declaration



- Mr. John Loh(Auditor) recommended current President's serving of consecutive terms, and Mr. Young-chan Sim(BOD)'s second request of it,
  - There was no special opinion on recommendation of Vice-presidents, President suggested serving of consecutive terms, and Mr. Sim agreed&all BOD's second request. So current Vice-presidents would be candidates,
- Cuurent 9 elected Board of Directors could serve of consecutive terms, but there were 1 resigned and 2 persons with losing contacts, so 3 new BOD could be elected. Mr. Trevor Mulaudzi(Vice-president) recommended Ms. Aifani Tahulela, but she was attending at the event as an observer, not even a member yet.
- Remarking that Ms. Tanya Khan(BOD) reminded all BOD of to require to form a board of directors with one representative from each country and also we need contenent representative. President suggested, 14 BOD shall be nominated, elected BOD would be 10 among them, and 6 current BOD would continue the roles, and elect 3 new BOD this time. After the GA, 5 more can be elected, and we will follow this kind of rules and standard(1 only from 1 country)
- Mr. Killian recommended 3 candidates.
- Presidents briefly introduce 3 candidates'(Mr. Sounh Manivong from Laos, Dr. Tariq Bin Yousuf from Bangladesh and Dr. Ki Hee Ryu from Korea) profile. Ms. Khan recommended the rule of 1 BOD from 1 Country, but President sought understanding on Dr. Ryu because 1 resigned BOD was from Korea too. After this event, when we elect new BOD, we will definitely follow the rule.

- With the second request of Mr. Chong-hae Kim(BOD) and Ms. Susan Roberts(Vice-president)




